Goals

- ***To encourage young people to help create a living, loving, vibrant community of God’s People within St. Joseph Faith Community.***
- ***To foster the personal and spiritual growth of each young person thru Catechesis by means of Scripture Study, Prayer, Holy Mass and Adoration.***
- ***To provide opportunities for young men and women of any race or nationality to discover and be reassured of their self-worth as individuals and as valuable members of St. Joseph Parish Community***
- ***To provide activities of a social, cultural, and recreational nature***

The St. Joseph Youth “Connect” Ministry is based upon Catholic Principles that reinforce sound human and social values. The Youth Ministry is open to all young men and women in grades 4-12 who attend private, public, or home schools.

Through the Eucharist, Christ unites the faithful in one body-the Church. Therefore, as the St. Joseph Youth strive to live out their Catholic Faith, it is imperative they are nourished by the Eucharist in the Mass. The last Sunday 11:00 Mass is designated as the Youth Mass. The children participate in the Mass as Greeters, Ushers, Altar Servers, Lectors, Cantors, Choir and Gift Bearers.

The St. Joseph Elementary Youth Ministry is open to children in the 4th and 5th grades.

The St. Joseph Jr. Youth Ministry is open to all teens in the 6-8 grades.

The St. Joseph Sr. Youth Ministry is open to all teens in the 9-12 grades.

The St. Joseph Youth Connect Ministry grades 4-12 meet the second and fourth Sundays in the Youth Room from 5:00 p.m. -7:00 p.m. September –May. Meetings consist of dinner, Praise & Worship Songs, games, and break out discussions from questions in the You Cat (Youth Catechism). The children are divided into groups for age appropriate discussions. We host the Room in the Inn Ministry twice a year. We participate in the Shepherd Center Thanksgiving & Christmas Meals Program.

The St. Joseph Jr. Youth Connect plan & participate in one youth retreat per year on the grounds of St. Joseph Church/School and also attend a Youth 2000 retreat.

The St. Joseph Sr. Youth Ministry attends a Youth 2000 Retreat each year. We attend the March for Life in January of each year. Juniors and seniors will be given the opportunity and encouraged to attend a Search Weekend Retreat as well as CYO Youth Leadership Camp in the summer. Students are given an opportunity to form a girls & boys basketball team to participate in CYO Hoops Program each year.
